2024 Tri-State Band Symposium - Audition Music

- (1) **CHROMATIC SCALE** Starting on any preferred pitch, perform at least two octaves, articulated on the way up, slurred on the way down.
- **SCALES -** Play <u>at least</u> three scales **with** arpeggios <u>(any major and/or minor scales are acceptable)</u>. Scales should be **at least** two octaves, articulated on the way up, and slurred on the way down, with an arpeggio. <u>Please announce scales before performing them.</u>
- **3 INTERPRETATION** Craft an <u>interpretation</u> of this excerpt that represents your most mature musicianship, including choices such as tempo, articulations, dynamics, phrasing, etc.
