I managed a budget of \$120,000.00, successfully gained re-accreditation of the program, and partnered with Fayette County School District's Early Start (Pre-K) program as the Director of

REGIONAL STEWARDSHIP EXPERIENCE

I collaborate with all entities that touch young children within the Northern Kentucky region as the regional stewardship faculty at Northern Kentucky University. These entities include the Northern Kentucky Education Council and the Boone, Campbell, Kenton, and Pendleton County Community Early Childhood Council. I work closely, especially, with the United Way of Greater Cincinnati's Success By 6, Northern Kentucky Director to facilitate meeting the 2020 goal of having 85% of children prepared for kindergarten in the region. When grants are funded, assisting with implementation of grant projects to the level needed – this includes being a project leader, advisor, trainer, content expert, etc.
- Developing evidence-based initiatives or programs for piloting and scaling to other communities:
 - ✓ United Way Born Learning Academy: A school-based family engagement program that fosters kindergarten readiness through a workshop series focusing on using everyday materials and moments for supporting children's learning. Co-developed with H. Harte in 2009.
 - ✓ Coaching to Quality: A collaborative coaching initiative that individually supports childcare programs in accessing Kentucky's quality rating system and provides a tiered system of support to increase the overall program quality to facilitate children's readiness for kindergarten. Co-developed with H. Harte and the Coaching to Quality leadership team in 2009.
 - ✓ A Taste of Learning: A grocery-based program that encourages families making healthy food choices and fostering children's learning opportunities during grocery shopping. Codeveloped with H. Harte in 2011.
