Responsibilities include teaching online and on-campus undergraduate and graduate special education courses. We are looking for a dynamic faculty member eager to teach, mentor, and advise the next generation of intervention specialists. Candidates must have an earned doctorate (or ABD) in special education or related field, or a master’s degree plus 18 semester hours in special education with related experience. Preference will be given to applicants with broad-based experience in special education across a variety of disability categories to support our current certification programs for high and/or low incidence disabilities. Experience with diverse populations, inclusive practices, and adapting for access of the general education curriculum is required. The position is a one-year, full-time temporary appointment.
